Regular Board Meeting – July 21, 2022 - Windsor Jr/Sr High School Library

Call to Order, Roll Call

President Michelle Schultz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Mr. Van Hoveln reported:

- Summer project update: A/C Units, Cleaning, ES Shed, Classroom Movement at ES, Gym Floor Refinishing, GS Parking lot, ES Flooring in the north wing
- 2. Update on Summer Lunch Program
- 3. New Teacher Mentoring: "Classroom Management Book Study"
- Expenditure rate will not be included until the budget is acted on by the board. Most likely it will be back in October.

Mr. Wiedman reported:

- Summer School started July 11 and runs through August 5th. We have 8 students in grades 1-3, 4 students in grades 4-6, and 5 students in grades 7-8.
- Registration will be August 4th from 10-6 and August 5th from 8-12. It will be held at the Windsor Jr/Sr High School. It will be ran mostly through teacherease in an online format. Parents have been contacted through an email, band app, facebook, and twitter.
- 3. The extra teacher days have been set.
 - Aug. 12 each building will conduct a curriculum day
 - Aug. 16 will be the stipend day and each building will run an Ed Camp and the afternoon will be meetings with new teachers and mentors
 - Aug. 17 (Institute Day) the teachers will be going to Stew-Stras where the districts are sharing a speaker. The speaker is Dr. Courtney Orzel and she will be explaining "the Why", a

reflection to why teachers are in education and a way to set our focus for the upcoming year.

4. Custodial Work = All rooms and hallways have been waxed and gym floors have finished. Some work to the HS baseball diamond has been accomplished with refilling dirt and they started to put new yellow tubing on the outfield fence.

Mr. Will reported:

- 1. Posted the school supply lists for the upcoming school year on the band app and facebook.
- 2. Summer Lunch Program:
 - Things started off slow, but numbers have been increasing especially with the start of summer school.
 - b. Everything has been running smoothly thanks to Julie Finley's efforts!
