BOARD OF EDUCATION
Regular Board Meeting – July 20, 2023 - Windsor Jr/Sr High School Library

1. Call to Order, Roll Call President Michelle Schultz called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

The following were present: Josh Cline, Matt Greuel, Christie Storm, Michelle Schultz, Karen Pfeiffer, Stacy Cole, Albert Shafer. Administrators Erik Van Hovel, Bart Wiedman, Jon Will were also present.

3. Reports, Updates, Informational Items

a. Superintendent Report

Mr. Van Hovel reported:

1. Summer project update: Window hinge replacement, painting, cleaning, waxing floors, new gym roof coating, flooring in 2 elementary school classrooms, fence repair, shrubs removed, replaced 3 window units and elementary school walk in cooler replacement.

Mr. Wiedman reported:

1. New Classes to be offered at WHS in 23-24
 - Animal Science / Vet Tech – Ag Dept.
 - Reading 7th and 8th Grade – English Dept.
 - Chemistry II – Science Dept.
 - Bringing Back this 23-24 school Year
 - Psychology
2. Updating the banners for the gyms with Jake at Herff Jones
 - That way they are all matching
 - We will be moving the JH banners to the Old Gym and adding a few from state softball teams
3. Summer School got started July 10 and will go until August 4 at the Elementary School.
 - 15 Students attending
 - 2 = Grades K-2
 - 8 = Grades 3-4
 - 2 = Grades 5-6
 - 3 = Grades 7-8

Mr. Will Reported:

1. Summer cleaning and maintenance has been progressing, and we expect to be ready for the beginning of the school year.

a. All classrooms have received a deep cleaning, and a number of repairs have been made.

b. New flooring has been installed in Mrs. Halbrook's and Mrs. Babb's classrooms.

2. MAP Testing outcomes:

. As a school we went from the 45th percentile in Math during the fall MAP test to the 51st percentile in Math during the spring MAP test. For reference during the previous school year we finished in the 50th percentile for Math during the spring MAP test. So as a building we showed a 6% improvement in Math during the year.

a. As a school we went from the 41st percentile in Reading during the fall MAP test to the 43rd percentile in Reading during the spring MAP test. For reference during the previous school year we finished in the 45th percentile for Reading during the spring MAP test. So as a building we showed a small 2% gain during the school year, but fell short from the previous school year.

b. Here are the results from fall to spring in Reading by grade level:

i.K - 58 to 69

ii.1st - 31 to 28

iii.2nd - 27 to 46

iv.3rd - 25 to 43

v.4th - 35 to 43

vi.5th - 51 to 53

vii.6th - 38 to 37

c. To summarize, as a building we struggled in reading, which is why we moved to restructure a large portion of our curriculum. We have seen some early success with Orton-Gillingham in year one, especially with our struggling students. The Wonders curriculum that was purchased better connects with Orton-Gillingham, and this should provide a boost to our students' academic success moving forward.

d. Here are the results from fall to spring in Math by grade level:

.K - 58 to 75

i.1st - 42 to 37

ii.2nd - 47 to 60

iii.3rd - 32 to 58

iv.4th - 54 to 46

v.5th - 27 to 36

vi.6th - 39 to 25

This fall we will be focusing on aligning the curriculum vertically from grade level to grade level, and adding more rigor to push students to new heights mathematically.



- c. Release of Executive Session Minutes: 12/21/22, 1/18/23, 2/15/23, 3/15/23, 4/19/23 & 5/10/23


